Edinburgh-based hand sanitiser producer ClearWater Hygiene has launched Track Trace + Monitor, a new tracking and monitoring service to help businesses stop the spread of Coronavirus.

The service, which is compatible with NHS systems, aims to help pubs, restaurants, shops and other customer-facing businesses better control the spread of the pandemic and minimise the potential of further lockdowns.

It allows a business to proactively control their own on-site records of staff and customer visits, while also enabling contact tracing through the NHS app if an individual does report an infection at a later stage.

Staff and customers can record their details without the need of a specific app, using simple point and scan QR code technology, which has enabled businesses to increase their track and trace compliance.

The data can then be accessed quickly and easily in order to share with the NHS Tracing Unit.

The new service is fully integrated with ClearWater's SMART stand dispenser unit which, together with the QR code, acts as a point of entry safeguard, enabling businesses to protect staff, visitors and customers.

The Track Trace + Monitor service, developed in partnership with secure database specialist Sprout, fully adheres to GDPR data protection rules and government policy throughout the UK.
